
Signs of an infestation - blood spots on the sheets 1 of 7

- There are three types of blood spots on sheets:
 - Fresh visible blood coloured, a strong indication that something is wrong but not necessarily
 Bedbugs – an inconclusive sign.
 - Processed blood meal very dark colour more black than red, a definitive sign when confirmed with BedBug BlueTM.
 - Old marks usually black and washed into the threads of the fabric, this is a cleaning issue not pest control.
- Knowing how to tell the difference is key to confirming an infestation.



Various blood spots 2 of 7





Blood spots that initial ally look the same can reveal a lot more when you look at them in detail. The following slides will illustrate this.

Fresh blood spots 3 of 7





Fresh blood spots are not confirming of bedbugs as they can have many other causes such as spots or allergies. They darken in colour with time to more of a rust colour and do not need testing with Bed Bug Blue™.


Processed blood meal 4 of 7





Faecal trace deposited on the sheet by a bloated bedbug. This colour needs to be confirmed with Bed Bug Blue™ but until it is then it's a strong indication of bedbugs.

Old blood spots 5 of 7






Old blood spots regardless of origin are a black colour. They should not be tested with Bed Bug Blue™. With each wash the stain will fade and spread out, the more diffused the older it is.

Faecal traces on a Passive Monitor 6 of 7



Faecal traces deposited on a Passive Monitor detection skirt are always dark brown to black in colour and can be confirmed with Bed Bug Blue™.
